What does the role involve?

- Providing haircuts and basic grooming services to individuals accessing the Homeless Hub.
- Creating a welcoming, friendly, and non-judgemental environment for clients.
- Engaging in positive and supportive conversations with individuals during appointments.
- Maintaining hygiene standards and ensuring the workspace is clean and tidy.
- Signposting clients to additional services and support where appropriate.
- Completing a short induction and any required training before starting.

What skills do I need?

- Experience as a hairdresser, barber, or stylist (formal qualifications are desirable but not essential).
- Compassionate and non-judgemental attitude.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Ability to work with vulnerable individuals in a respectful and professional manner.
- Understanding of confidentiality and boundaries in a support setting.
- Willingness to follow health and safety procedures.

What will I gain?

- The opportunity to make a direct and positive impact on individuals' confidence and self-esteem
- A deeper understanding of the challenges faced by individuals experiencing homelessness
- Improved interpersonal and communication skills
- The chance to be part of a caring and supportive team
- Paid expenses as well as induction and any necessary training.
